DO NOT WAIT FOR THE RUN ORDER TO BE PUBLISHED AS IT WILL BE TOO LATE BY THEN.

NOTE: Due to unexpected larger entry numbers than expected, we are moving two classes per day to the Red building on Friday and Saturday. All courses are designed by Scott Lovelis, and Scott will be judging in the Green building and Dave Mueller will be judging in the Red Building.

Competitors for those classes will be assigned to groups so there will be NO conflicts. In MOST cases team members are in the same group.

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Running orders will be available sometime Wednesday at [www.dognutmom.com](http://www.dognutmom.com). We will not have extra copies, so please print and bring your own. We will also be using Agility Gate.

We will be using the **saloon tire** at this trial. It will be available each morning until the end of the first class for familiarization. We will also demonstrate how to change the height during the briefing for those that are unfamiliar with this style of tire.

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## CRATING, PARKING AND OTHER INFORMATION

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This trial will be held in the green building.

**The trial site is open to exhibitors at 7:00am all 3 days. Do not arrive before 7am! NO SET UP ON THURSDAY.** Orchard Hills is located on private property and is NOT open to the public outside of event hours. Waiting on the driveway or on Church Street prior to the facility opening is not allowed. The premises are closed when the show committee leaves for the day and all competitors must exit by that time. Admission on the premises outside of stated hours is not permitted and is considered trespassing. If you need access to the property outside of stated hours due to extenuating circumstances, you will need to obtain permission of the show chairperson and/or the property owner. If you find yourself arriving early for an event, there is a Turkey Hill north on 100 and a Redners and Dunkin Donuts south on 100.

You may only crate in the green building, first come, first served. Ground cover is required under crates. Only use Xpens for 3 or more dogs. **Due to larger numbers, we ask that you be considerate of others and condense your set up as much as possible.**

You may also crate out of your car, or you may bring EZ Ups and crate in the designated outdoor crating area. If crating out of the car, do not leave the car running with a/c if YOU ARE NOT IN THE CAR. Even though we have recently received rain, there is still a risk of grass fires.

Car and RV parking patterns may be slightly different than at a local trial, so please listen to the parking assistants!

There are limited handicapped parking spots available to those with a handicapped placard or license plate. **Email** Rosemarie Huey at [dncswhooves@gmail.com](mailto:dncswhooves@gmail.com)

There are indoor rest rooms for people only ... no dogs in the rest rooms.

Please use the designated potty area to the right of the red building in the first sheep pen behind the propane tank and clean up after your dogs. There are buckets and scoopers available. Do not potty dogs anywhere near the building. You may use the sheep pens directly next to the potty area to run your dog

You may also use the area behind the buildings to potty your dogs. Please pick up after your dog in this area

Baby pools with water will be available.

There is a \$10 potty fine for any dogs pottying in any area other than the designated area, ESPECIALLY on or around either of the buildings! There is also a \$10 potty fine for any dog pottying inside the building.

Obey the speed limit when driving on North Church Street. Police have been known to issue tickets for speeding.

Absolutely no competitors/dogs allowed on the property to the left as you are coming up the long driveway.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. No prizes, ribbons or awards will be mailed.

No celebratory balloons are permitted on the premises. These have caused damage to the fans inside the buildings in the past.

As with all spectator venues, you are encouraged to present yourself and your dog in the best manner possible, including attire and sportsmanship. Help us to preserve such venues by following all show ground rules. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

## FOOD

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**We will have a food vendor on Friday and Saturday only.** The original food vendor was unable to come to this trial. You will need to plan accordingly for Sunday.

## RV RESERVATIONS

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Onsite RV parking with NO Hookups, was available on a reservation only basis, first come, first served. RV parking will be restricted to designated parking areas only.

If you signed up for an RV reservation, see Vincent Madeiros upon arrival. **Payment is due upon arrival.** You should have received a separate email regarding RV parking from Cindy & Vincent Madeiros before the event.

## BITCHES IN SEASON

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Bitches in Season ("BIS") will be allowed to run at this Regional event. Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary that they will be running a bitch in season. BIS must start on a mat OR may run in VERY WELL FITTING panties – no droopy drawers!! The BIS will run in their assigned position in the run order and "BIS" will be notated next to the name on the gate sheet.

The handler of a BIS should minimize exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limit their movements about the grounds. We also request that the BIS be crated in the car/RV. The BIS should wear sanitary britches when moving about the grounds.

MULLIGAN RUNS – there will be NO Mulligan runs at this event

## CHECK-IN & MEASURING

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No competitors may enter premises prior to 7am all three days

Check-in: 7:15am, briefing at 7:40am, judging at 8am

All times are tentative and subject to change. Please stay tuned to announcements throughout the weekend for schedule changes.

There will be two types of check-in, Full Service and Express. Each dog is a unique entry; just because one dog may not need to check-in/measure-in does not mean that all of your dogs entered are able to do so as well.

Full-service check-in is required if you did not provide permanent height card info for a dog (copy of plastic card, copy of USDAA print out or a copy of AKC permanent height card. Those who cannot present their permanent or completed temporary USDAA cards, or copy of info page, or whose dogs are NOT jumping the maximum height, will be required to "measure-in". .

## MEASURING FOR REGIONAL EVENTS

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Dogs that are entered in tournament events and do not have a permanent yellow or white height card MUST be measured if their temporary card does NOT have 3 measurements. If you have a completed blue card or measuring sheet and are waiting for the 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday measurement, just show the card. This policy does not apply to dogs entered in test classes only or to those dogs jumping Ch24" or P20"

Also, if you are due a refund, still owe us money or need to hand in your GP vouchers, please use full-service check-in. If you do owe us money, this must be paid at time of check-in or you will not be permitted to run.

If you have either one 1<sup>st</sup> place GP voucher or two non first place GP vouchers and your dog is NOT entered in GP Finals on Sunday, let me know asap. If you earned two vouchers since entering this trial, you MUST bring the physical vouchers to check and and let me know!!

## DIRECTIONS

From I-78 North and points East or West: Take the PA-29 S exit- EXIT #55- toward EMMAUS, turn slightly right onto S CEDAR CREST BLVD / PA-29. Follow Route 29 south for approximately 9.5 miles then merge onto Route 100 south. After 3.7 miles you will see Longacres Electrical Supplies on your left, you make a right there onto North Church Street. \*Obey the speed limit in this area or you will be ticketed, continue straight onto Crow Hill Road up a hill to Belle Vista Lane on your left just past a small pond. You can see the white building on top of the hill.

From Philadelphia and points South East: I-76 W toward VALLEY FORGE, take the US-202 S / US-202 N / US-422 W exit- EXIT 328B-A- toward WEST CHESTER / KING OF PRUSSIA / POTTSTOWN / SWEDES FORD RD. Merge onto US-422 W for 21.9 miles then take the PA-100 N exit toward ALLENTOWN for about 12.5 miles. You will see Longacres Electrical Supply on your right, make a left onto North Church Street and follow directions in above.

Pa Turnpike/NE Extension: to Quakertown Exit, bear right onto Route 663 South. As you enter Pennsburg you will make a right onto Route 29 North. Follow Route 29 to the town of Hereford (Turkey Hill and Light) Turn Left onto Route 100 South and follow into Barto, you will see Longacres Electrical Supplies on your left, you make a right there onto North Church Street and follow directions in above.
