NO CHANGES regardless of fault after 10am on Wed June 3!!

Check your confirmation carefully, especially for jump heights and class levels!

DO NOT WAIT UNTIL YOU SEE THE RUNNING ORDER! Printing will be DONE.

I also have to get ready for the Keystone Regional the following weekend and will be staying in PA between these two trials, so I ALSO have to get ready for that – I will be under a time crunch, so, please, please no changes after this time!!

NOTE: If you owe money or Grand Prix Bys for the Keystone Regional the following weekend, BRING IT WITH YOU TO THIS TRIAL!! It will help at check in time!

CRATING, PARKING AND OTHER INFORMATION

The trial site is open to exhibitors at **7:15am** Saturday & Sunday. Absolutely no competitors may enter the driveway before 7:15am. Orchard Hills is located on private property and is NOT open to the public outside of event hours. Waiting on the driveway or on Church Street prior to the facility opening is not allowed. The premises are closed when the show committee leaves for the day and all competitors must exit by that time. Admission on the premises outside of stated hours is not permitted and is considered trespassing. If you need access to the property outside of stated hours due to extenuating circumstances, you will need to obtain permission of the show chairperson and/or the property owner. If you find yourself arriving early for the event, there is a Turkey Hill north on 100 and Redners and Dunkin Donuts south on 100.

ABSOLUTELY NO COMPETITORS/DOGS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY TO THE LEFT AS YOU ARE COMING UP THE LONG DRIVEWAY.

Dogs are not allowed in the indoor bathrooms.

Please use the designated potty area to the right of the red building in the first pen behind the propane tank and clean up after your dogs. There are buckets and scoopers available.

You may use the two sheep pens directly next to the potty area to run your dog.

Dogs must remain on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring or in the warm-up jump area.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded; no awards will be mailed.

RV Parking was "in advance" reservation only through Cindy Madeiros.

Obey the speed limit when driving on North Church Street. Police have been known to issue tickets for speeding!

Don't forget to add any new titles that you and your dog earn in our New Title Book which will be at the ribbon table! I'll make an announcement to FaceBook about everyone's accomplishments!

FOOD

There WILL be a food vendor – The Wounded Warriors will be there all weekend.

BITCHES IN SEASON:

Bitches in season (BIS) will be allowed at this trial and will be starting on a mat (please bring your own) OR VERY WELL FITTING panties. BIS will run in their assigned order in the run order with a BIS marked beside their name. Please let the gate steward know for all BIS so that we can mark them appropriately. For Standard classes, all BIS will run at the very end of the class and the table will be cleaned before the next class. Please see the official policy statement for full explanation.

FIX & CONTINUE:

For Fix & Continue (F&C) the competitor will be allowed to immediately repeat any obstacle (other than a spread hurdle or long jump) if it is faulted or if the dog, in the competitor's sole discretion, did not meet their desired performance criteria; F&C automatically incurs an elimination. The competitor may repeat one or more relevant preceding obstacles prior to the point of error if it is beneficial to their performance of the obstacle. An F&C may be employed only once during the run. Once an elimination has been scored, the maximum course time shall be retroactively established at 60 seconds. Please see the official policy statement for full explanation.

MULLIGAN RUNS:

We will be NOT be offering Mulligan Runs

CHECK IN & MEASURING

No competitors may enter premises (this pertains to parking areas or buildings) prior to 7:15am on Saturday and Sunday. Please do not arrive in the parking lot before these times as our club members need the time for trial set up!! There will be absolutely no competitor setup on Friday.

Check-in and measuring shall be between 7:15am - 7:45am in the green building with the judge's briefing/walk throughs starting shortly thereafter and judging to start at 8am.

Measuring will be required for those who cannot present their permanent or completed temporary USDAA cards, print out of the dog's data page from the USDAA site, or whose dogs are NOT jumping the maximum jump height. Those who have not been measured or checked-in prior to running may forfeit their runs.

If you are unsure of the check-in/measuring-in procedure, odds are you need to have your dog measured. Bring your dogs that need measuring AND their temporary height sheet to the measuring line BEFORE getting in the check-in line. You need to print out the height sheet from your dog's page on your usdaa account. Click the blue box below their name. You keep that sheet until your dog has all required measurements.

You may also supply a copy of your dog's AKC permanent height card if you have one. Unfortunately, I am no longer able to accept UKI permanent height information.

Orchard Hills Training Center

From I-78 North and points East or West: Take the PA-29 S exit- EXIT #55- toward EMMAUS, turn slightly right onto S CEDAR CREST BLVD / PA-29. Follow Route 29 south for approximately 9.5 miles then merge onto Route 100 south. After 3.7 miles you will see Longacres Electrical Supplies on your left, you make a right there onto North Church Street. *Obey the speed limit in this area or you will be ticketed, continue straight onto Crow Hill Road up a hill to Belle Vista Lane on your left just past a small pond. You can see the white building on top of the hill.

From Philadelphia and points South East: I-76 W toward VALLEY FORGE, take the US-202 S / US-202 N / US-422 W exit- EXIT 328B-A- toward WEST CHESTER / KING OF PRUSSIA / POTTSTOWN / SWEDES FORD RD. Merge onto US-422 W for 21.9 miles then take the PA-100 N exit toward ALLENTOWN for about 12.5 miles. You will see Longacres Electrical Supply on your right, make a left onto North Church Street and follow directions in above.

Pa Turnpike/NE Extension: to Quakertown Exit, bear right onto Route 663 South. As you enter Pennsburg you will make a right onto Route 29 North. Follow Route 29 to the town of Hereford (Turkey Hill and Light) Turn Left onto Route 100 South and follow into Barto, you will see Longacres Electrical Supplies on your left, you make a right there onto North Church Street and follow directions in above.
