Running Orders will be on my site: www.dognutmom.com by Thursday afternoon. We will not be providing copies, so please print your own.

Course copies will be available on my site: www.dognutmom.com UKI rules only allow us to publish course maps at the time the site opens. USDAA maps will be available by 10pm Thursday evening. We will have a copy posted so that you can take a picture with your phone.

For UKI: Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 10. If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. If you ask for a challenge measure when you have a permanent measure, you must state this when you are getting the dog measured so the correct protocol can be followed and you may not continue to challenge a measure when you have challenged it once.

For USDAA: ALL dogs not having a permanent card/printout from the USDAA website showing permanent status will need to be measured if you have not mailed a copy of the permanent card/printout in advance, or if your dog is NOT jumping Ch24" or P20". You may also email me a copy of your permanent card or printout and save the check-in hassle. You can take a picture of the card/printout with your phone and email it. You can also send me a copy of your AKC Permanent Height card if you have one. We are no longer permitted to accept UKI permanent height status.

If you are relatively new to USDAA, you do need to print out the temporary measuring sheet from your dog's page on the USDAA site – it has all of your dog's information on it. You will need to get that sheet signed by the judge and then keep it until you have all the required measurements

Please volunteer when you can! This is a one ring trial so no conflicts!

We will also be offering Mulligan Runs for \$5/run all 3 days for all classes unless we start to go too late in the day

Some site information:

If it is a wet and muddy weekend, you will NEED to bring a clean pair of shoes to wear in the ring. No muddy shoes in the ring. Also, no muddy dog feet in the ring.

Indoor “real” bathrooms – please don’t bring your dogs inside with you 😊

Use mats under your crates in the crating area.


Plenty of room to run your dogs outside, but please pick up after your dogs. Don’t let your dog pee on the building, handicapped signs, trash cans or right outside the door.

There are dog kennels set up behind the agility arena, both for boarding dogs and the owners’ personal dogs. Please be aware of their space and play with your dogs outside in front of the building and along the property on the driveway side. You **MUST** pick up after your dog and dispose of the waste in the dumpster or in the outside trash cans. Do **NOT** put the waste in ANY indoor trash can!

There will **NOT** be a food vendor, so please plan according. There is a list of nearby food establishments on the last page of this confirmation.

Bitches in season are allowed and will run in their assigned spot in the run order EXCEPT for Advanced/P2 and Starters/P1 Standard where they will run at the end of the class. Either bring a mat for the dog to start on in the ring, OR may run in VERY WELL fitting “bitches britches” – no droopy drawers!!!

Don’t forget to add any new titles that you and your dog earn in the New Title Book – I’ll make brag announcements on FaceBook

From Cleveland: I480 East to Rt 14 SE for 43.9 miles. To Washingtonville, OH 44490. Turn Right onto Painters Path across from the Pharmacy. South on Painters Path for 1600 feet.

From Akron: I76 East to Rt 14 SE, then follow above directions

From the South: Rt 7 North to Rt 11N (25.2mi) to Rt 46, at exit ramp turn Right onto rt 46(2.3 mi). At first traffic light turn right onto Rt 14W(4.1 miles). Turn Left onto Painters Path at the top of the hill in Washingtonville, OH. Travel 1600 feet to building.

From I-80 in Western PA: I-80 West into Ohio. Take Rt 11 south to SR46. Then follow directions from the south.
